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Registration

Regulations Related to Course Scheduling

Students have a prescribed schedule, and have been assigned specific courses and sections of the curriculum. Yearly schedules all the activities, assignments, classes and academic commitments.

Senior Years Groups

Senior team students in the In Rega ed Pogram have been assigned the following (Senior team students in the Affe Degree students have been assigned a separate group). Each group has been assigned a specific schedule for the **Certification Year 5 Registration Report** indicates the group which has been assigned, and the section and course have been made.

Senior Years Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment Courses

Year 5 Senior Year students will continue taking specialized Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment (CIA) courses in their major and minor subjects.

Senior Years Advanced Curricular Inquiry (ACI)

Students will be assigned a section of EDUC-4761 SY(9-12) Advanced Curricular Inquiry (ACI). The purpose of the ACI course is for students to engage in a research project, the objectives of the student learn plan and enact the course of the student-in action and identify building feedback learning.

Practicum Blocks III and IV

Students will register for the extended block of practicum in Year 5. Practicum block are extended block course number, and are each worth 3 credit hours. In addition to the registration fee, students will be charged a practicum administrative fee of \$186.50 per block (\$373 for the year).

Students will register for EDUC-4776-150 Practicum Block III SY in the Fall term, and EDUC-4777-150 Practicum Block IV SY in the Winter term. Please ensure that you register for the appropriate practicum block.

In addition to the block, students must attend the full day half day or week in their school. Students may choose an full half day or high school class schedule, and are not required to attend for the week of the teaching time.

Other Year 5 Courses

Each group has been assigned a specific section of the following courses: EDUC-4401 Job and Effective Schools; EDUC-4405 Content Analysis in In-Course Education; and EDUC-4604 Classroom-Based Assessment.

French, Kinesiology, Mathematics

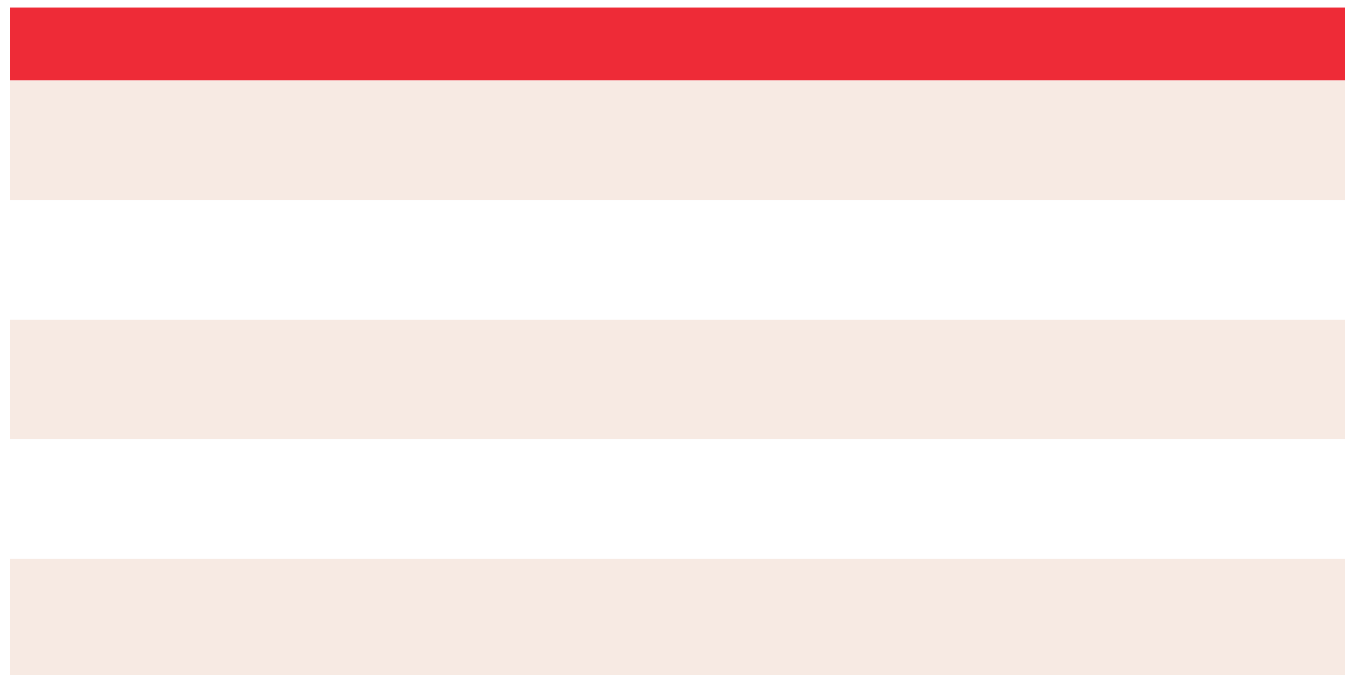

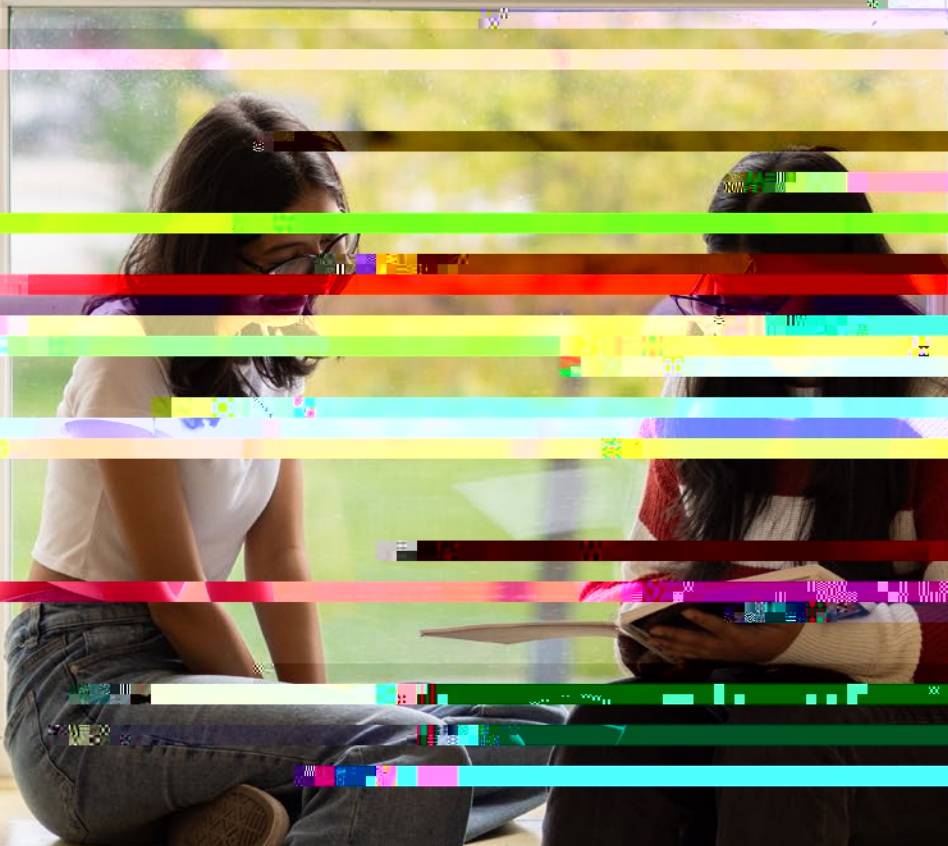
